





How many books do you read? Do you like reading books? Today I will talk about reading.

I like reading and I usually read three or four books in a month. Look at this. This is a graph which shows how [4] in a month. According to this graph, about (5) percent of people read more than three books in a month. I was surprised to find that almost (6) of people read no books. Many people say that 7 , but I think they can find time for reading. They can read a book while they are on the train or while they are waiting for someone, for example.

【真美さんのスピーチ】

Learning English has become an important part of my life. I really became interested in English when I met a student from Australia. Her name is Nancy.

Nancy is in Japan now. This is her second time to come to Japan. Last time she stayed at my house for two weeks. We have known each other for five years. When she came to Japan for the first time, she was a junior high school student and I was an elementary school student. I couldn't speak English and she couldn't speak Japanese well at that time, but we tried to communicate by using gestures. After going back to Australia, she studied Japanese in high school. She wants to be a Japanese teacher in Australia, so she has come to Japan again to study Japanese and Japanese culture in college.

One day Nancy visited my house. I was very happy to see her again. We enjoyed talking together for a long time. I was very surprised because Nancy spoke Japanese very well. It was difficult for me to speak English then, but I really wanted to speak it well. I asked her how she learned Japanese. She taught me how to study a foreign language. One of the ways is to try to use the language. Nancy doesn't (①) a chance to use Japanese. She often joins festivals and other events in her town and talks a lot with people in Japanese. I told her that I only had a few chances to use English in Japan. Then she said to me, "Why don't you go to the community center next Sunday?"

At the community center, they were having a party called the International Day. On the second Sunday of each month, students from foreign countries and Japanese people get together and cook food from each country, play games, and enjoy some events. The ② [is / language / there / use / we] English. Some students cannot speak Japanese, but we can communicate with each other in English. That was a good chance for me to speak English. I enjoyed talking with students from foreign countries in English on the first day. I felt really happy when they understood what I wanted to say. It's fun and I go there every month now.

One thing I found at the party is that people from different countries speak different kinds of English. I thought they spoke the (③) English all over the world, but it's not true. I'll give you two examples. First, the accents are a little different in each country. Nancy's accent is not like the accent of a student from India. The students from other countries also have other accents. Because of that, it was difficult to understand their English at first. Second, some people use different expressions. For example, English in India has a word, "lakh." This word comes from Hindi, a language spoken in India. "Lakh" means one hundred thousand. Some people in India say, "Ten lakh people live in my city." That means, "One million people live in my city." I learned that English in each country is influenced by the culture and the [④] people speak.

I study English to communicate with a lot of people. Many people use English around the world. By using English, we can enjoy communication with people from foreign countries. We can learn about a different culture and a different way of life from people who speak a different language. 5 English is a window to the world. I want to study English harder. Then I can make more friends and learn a lot of things from people all over the world.
