Scholarships for annual payment and payment from July to March of the following year

The Shiga Prefectural Board of Education provides scholarships that do not need to be repaid to guardians (or other eligible persons) in low-income households (whose prefectural and municipal taxes based on income are 0 yen [taxexempt]) with high school students enrolled in national and public high schools, or other eligible students or schools.

1. Eligibility

Guardians in households that meet all of the following qualifications as of July 1 of the academic year of application

- Have high school (or other schools) students who are eligible to receive high school tuition support funds, relearning support funds, or advanced course tuition support funds
- Receive welfare benefits (which must include occupational assistance), or have prefectural and municipal taxes on an income basis that are 0 yen (tax-exempt) for the academic year of application (If there are two or more guardians, they must all be exempt from paying prefectural and municipal taxes.)
- Have guardians (or other persons) with an address in Shiga Prefecture

2. Payment classification

Please apply according to the applicable category:

(1) Annual payment

Eligible high school students > Other than new students in the academic year of application

➤ New students in the academic year of application who wish to receive annual payment (students who have not applied for the early payment of some benefits)

(2) From July to March of the following year

Eligible high school students > New students in the academic year of application who have applied for the early payment of some benefits

The scholarship amount for benefits from July to March of the following year is obtained by subtracting the early benefit amount from the annual payment determined from the payment category as of July 1. If the early benefit amount exceeds the annual payment, the annual payment amount is used.

 - Persons aged 15 or over (excluding junior high school students) and under 23
 - · High school or other students aged 23 and over
